Download the EPS file in your preferred language and this guideline and send it to your supplier along with the additional text and logos you would like to have printed on your item. The grey areas in this guideline (which are not to be printed) indicate the space reserved for your text and logo.

Your printer can open the EPS file in Adobe Illustrator CS4 or later versions and add text and logos in line with the draft on this page. We recommend that your printer uses a sans serif font style for any additional text. For any additional logos your printer will get the best result if you provide vector files (e.g. Illustrator.eps).

We recommend you use a white t-shirt for maximum visibility, consistency with branding on this campaign, and for environmental impact (coloured shirts require dyes and processing).
