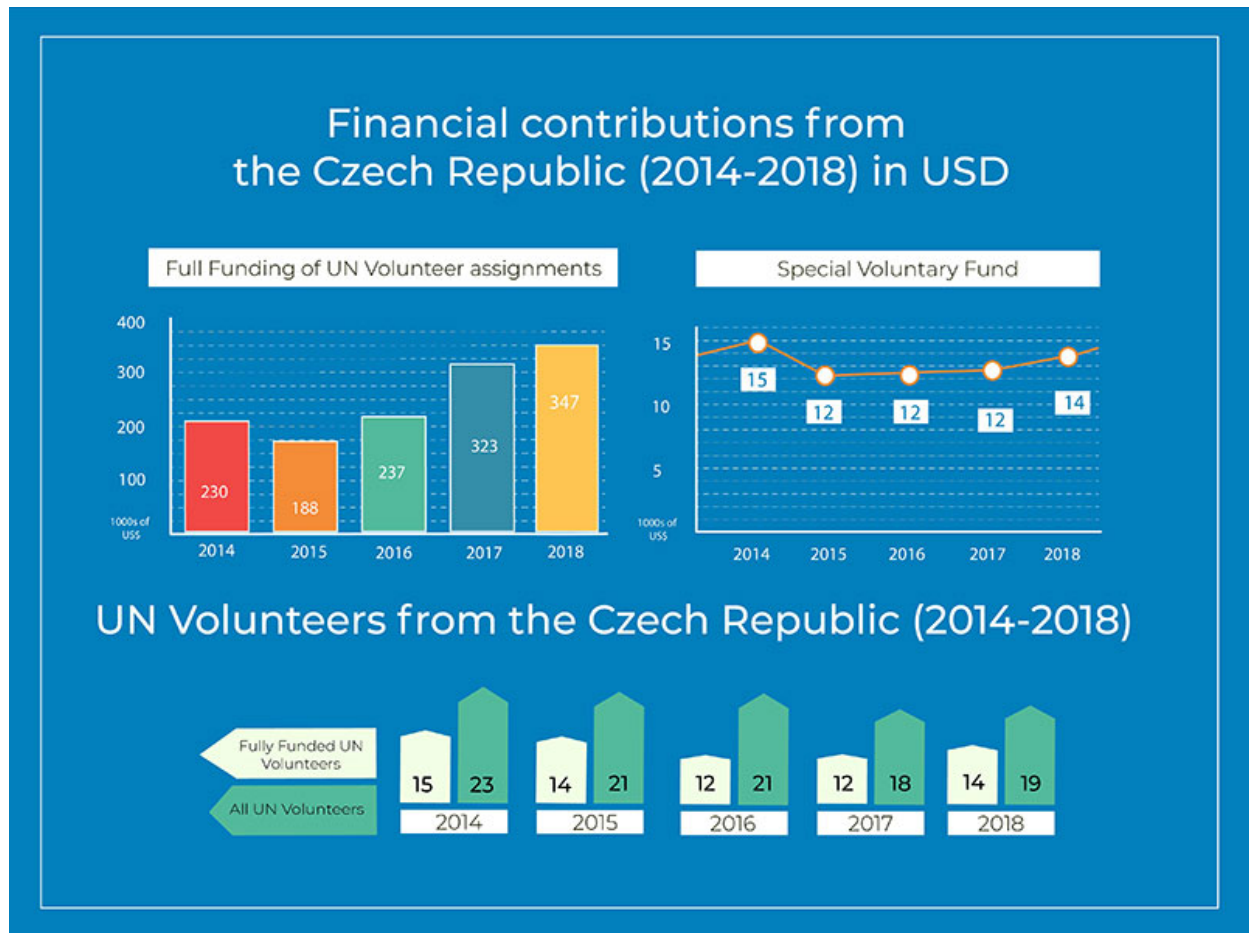

In 2018, 19 Czech nationals served as UN Volunteers, 14 of whom were funded by the Government of the Czech Republic. The Government also provides a contribution to UNV's Special Voluntary Fund (SVF), a flexible resource to implement UNV's Strategic Framework.

In addition, the Czech Republic was one of the 124 co-sponsors of the UN General Assembly Resolution on "[Volunteering for the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development](#)" in 2018.

In the same year, the Government submitted a National Situation Analysis on Volunteering, in the context of the [Plan of Action to integrate volunteering in the 2030 Agenda](#).
