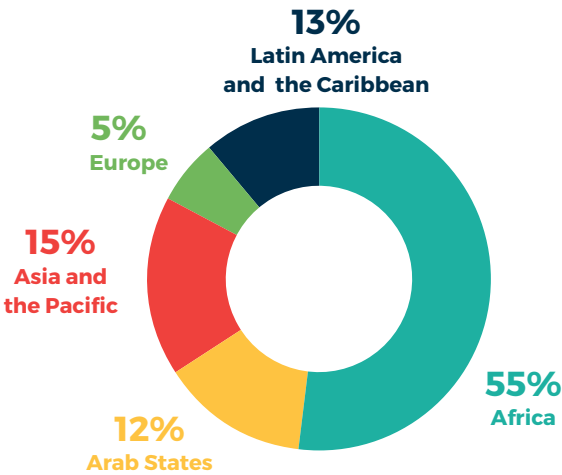

Total financial volume – all sources of funds (Thousands of US\$)

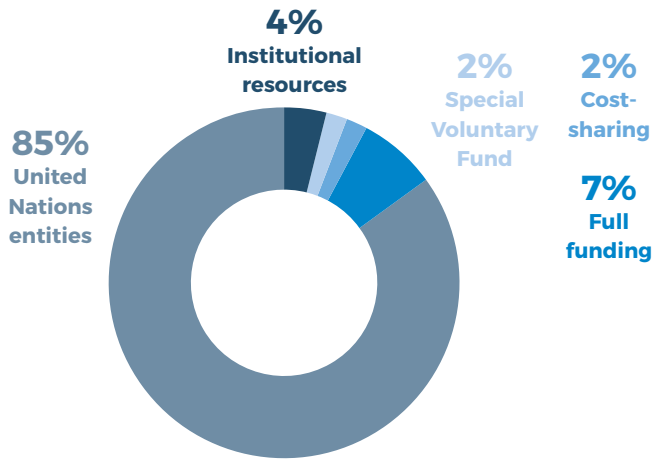

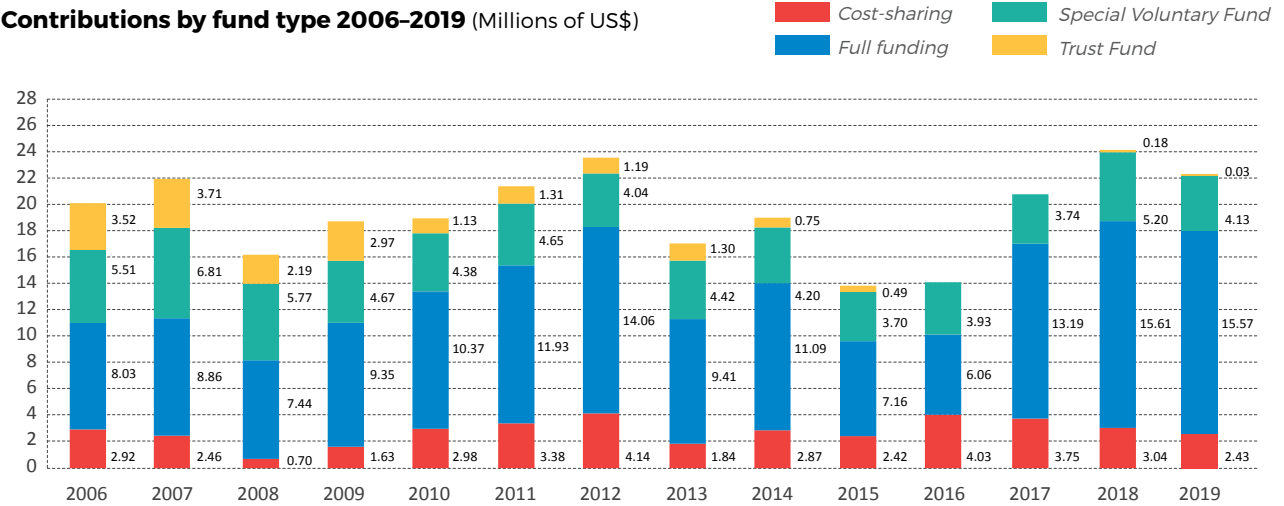

Contributions by fund type 2006–2019 (Millions of US\$)

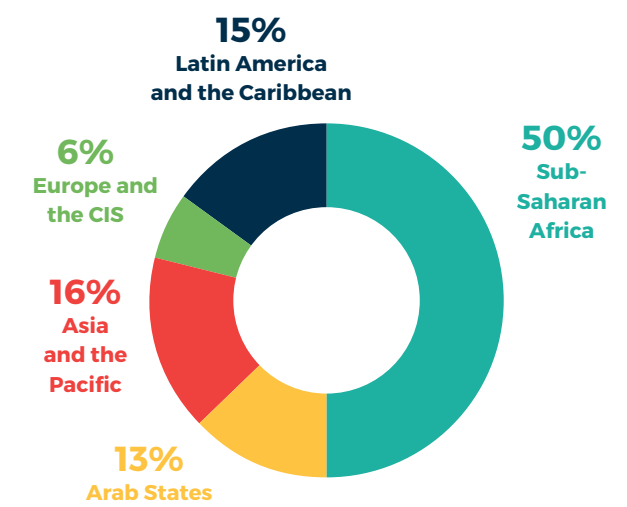

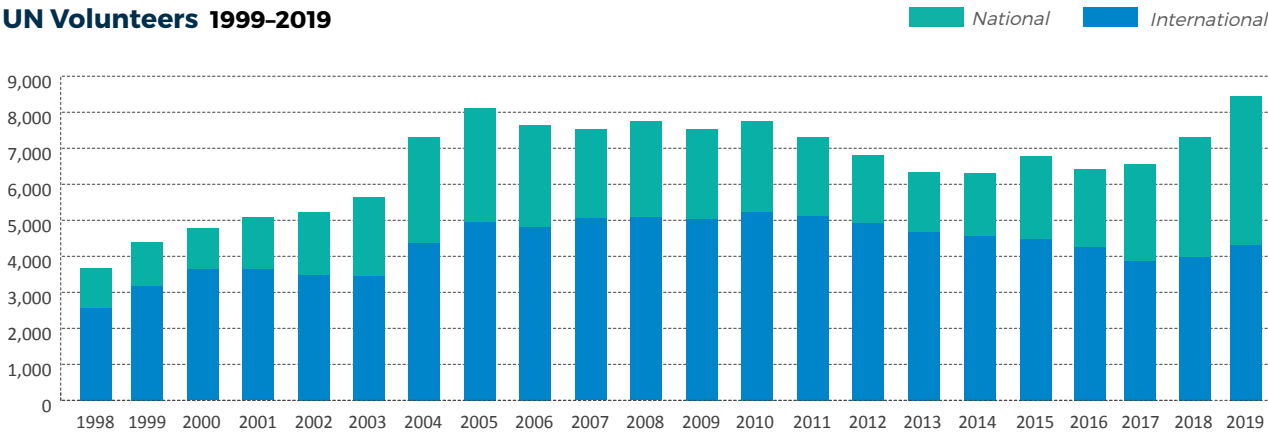

UN Volunteers by region



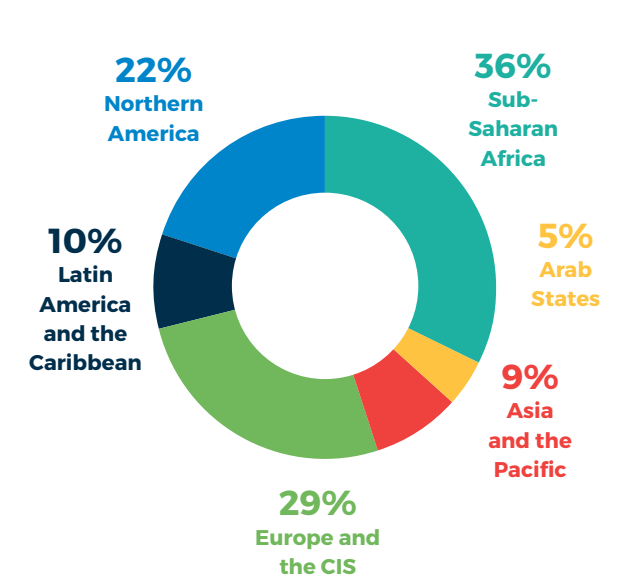
UN Volunteers 1999-2019
