UNV has undergone a holistic review of the Conditions of Service for UN Volunteers (COS). The revision of the COS are a result of a review process which has yielded an updated, workable instrument. This reviewed document and policies better suit these changing needs of UN Volunteers, retain UNV as an attractive, cost effective modality to UN partners, and streamline volunteer management procedures.

TWO CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

International: University, Youth, Specialist National: University, Youth, Specialist Policy Note for Community and Expert Volunteers

UNIFIED CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

International: Youth, Specialist, Expert National: Community, Youth, Specialist, Expert/ University Category under Special Programme



US \$250 for 1 dependent US \$450 for 2 or more

Tickets, insurance and inclusion of dependents extended to all UN Youth Volunteers. University remain single status due to short duration. Family Allowance extended to International Youth



CERTIFIED SICK LEAVE ACCRUAL

2.5 days per month of contract

UNCERTIFIED SICK LEAVE

4 days up to 6 months 7 days < 6 months per every 12 months

NO REQUIREMENT FOR UNOG VALIDATION

CERTIFIED SICK LEAVE

Calculation streamlined using annual 30 days. After 20 days sick leave, the case is referred to UNOG. Separation policy delegated to Host Entity.

UNCERTIFIED SICK LEAVE

7 days per annual cycle



Multiple combinations and complex

Possibility for national and international UN Volunteers to be reassigned within the same Host Entity, same country, same category



MLA (monthly living allowance) adjusted on a monthly basis per the United Nations International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) Post Adjustment Multiplier (PAM) for the country of assignment, to reflect differences in the cost of living and purchasing power across the world.

Post Adjustment Multiplier (PAM) established at capital city rate

When the UN Volunteer has a spouse in the UN system, Family Allowance (children) and Travel Allowance for the Home Visit do not apply



US \$500/12 months Learning activities approved and paid by 30 September 2021



Distinctions between serving period as Youth and Specialist

In a lifetime, one can serve a maximum of four years as a national UN Volunteer and another four years as an international UN Volunteer



Individuals meeting the eligibility criteria may receive an accommodation allowance supplement

Phased out as an individual entitlement.
Duty station wide supplement
delegated to Regional Offices and
New York Office.



Two weeks

The current determination guided from the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) and the UN Department of Safety & Security (DSS) is not exhaustive UN Volunteers placed in unclassified duty stations receive Well-Being Differential established at capital city rate. Duty station wide Well-Being Differential determination delegated to Regional Offices
