Online volunteering is easy, effective and fast. 500,000 volunteers are ready and only a mouse-click away. Their expertise ranges from data analysis to logo design to project development. You can mobilize extra capacity for your team within less than a week.

The United Nations Volunteers (UNV) programme invites you to a dedicated webinar on how to recruit and use online volunteers to boost your organization's skills and capacity. Online volunteers can help you with translations, in the design of logos and leaflets, in the conception of local campaigns, with background research and in project development, in developing training material, monitoring social media, as well as in collecting and analyzing data.

The UNV Online Volunteering service is a platform that puts non-profit organizations into contact with volunteers from everywhere around the world – to work together, over the internet, for peace and development. The webinar will show you how to register your organization for the Online Volunteering service, how to present volunteer opportunities which attract the people you need, and how to select and manage the best online volunteers. Moreover, users from the region will talk about their experience with the service. During the Q&A session you will also have the opportunity to ask questions. The webinar will be hosted by Annika Diederich, Programme Associate, from UNV headquarters.
