Living Provisions



Monthly Living Allowance (MLA)	60% of the VLA for an International UN Volunteer
Settling-in-Grant (SIG)	50% UN Youth Volunteer MLA when Applicable
Transportation/Commuting	Covered in the VLA

Local Language Learning	Provided if necessary
Induction Training	e-Campus
In-Service Training	Provided by Host Agency

Leave Entitlements



Annual leave	2 working days per completed month of volunteer assignment
Sick leave	4 Days uncertified 15 Days certified in 6 month period
Family leave	For urgent and unforeseen circumstances

Post Service Benefits



Medical benefits	1 month coverage after assignment
Travel benefits	When applicable travel is reimbursed
