

Step-by-step guide to register in the national UNV talent pool in your country

If you are already registered in UNV database of candidates and have your roster number, or if you have started your registration in our database, please follow the 3 steps below:

1. Access your UNV profile in our VMAM platform at <http://vmam.unv.org>
2. Click at the “My Profile” tab:
