Pre-Departure Facilitation



Pre-departure expenses	\$75
Shipment of personal Effects	Reimbursed when applicable
Travel to the duty station	Reimbursed when applicable

Living Provisions



Monthly Living Allowance (MLA)	80% of the VLA for a National UN Volunteer
Settling-In-Grant (SIG)	100% UN Youth Volunteer MLA when Applicable
Transportation/Commuting	Covered in VLA

Health, Safety and Security



Well-Being Differential	Differential A \$500 a month Differential B \$1000 a month
Rest and Recuperation (R&R)	Dependent on Host Agency
Medical and other insurance	Medical, life, disability, dismemberment, provided
Security	100% reimbursement per rules with UNDSS

Leave Entitlements



Annual leave	2 working days per completed month of volunteer assignment
Sick leave	7 Days uncertified 30 Days certified in 12 month period
Family leave	For urgent and unforeseen circumstances

Professional & Career Training Benefits



Local Language Learning	Provided if necessary
Induction Training	E-Campus and Assignment Preparation Training (APT)
Learning and Training allowance	Up to \$500 for 12 month assignments
In-Service Training	Provided by Host Agency

Post Service Benefits



Resettlement allowance (RSA)	1/24 th of MLA accrued per month of satisfactory service
Medical benefits	1 month coverage after assignment
Travel benefits	When applicable travel is reimbursed
