#### **Fast Track Recruitment**

If partners propose a qualified candidate for recruitment, partners can bypass the selection process and deploy UN

Volunteers faster.

#### **Emergency Context Recruitment**

Recruitment of UN Volunteers. which takes just 22 business days for Nationals on average, can be speeded up in emergency contexts.
