What have UNV done to support the COVID-19 response in Yemen and the Arab States?

Following a history of critical support to UN partners in the responses to Ebola and SARS, UNV are now responding to COVID-19, with a range of UN Volunteers assigned to the response in Yemen, including:

- ▶ **18 Doctors and Nurses** for UN CLINIC
- ▶ **Midwives and Programme Officers** for UNFPA
- ▶ **Human Rights Officers and Translators** for OHCHR
