Online volunteering provides UN organizations with:

- Speedy recruitment: within 72 hours of posting request.
- Diverse talent: over 287,000 candidates worldwide.
- Safety: Volunteers support from their own homes.
- Flexibility and cost-free: no contracts or charges.





How can Online Volunteers support you?

Online Volunteers can support your delivery in various areas, including, but not limited to:

- Creating communication materials, media monitoring, and tracking false information.
- Translation and interpretation (Arabic <> English).
- Collecting data, preparing situation analyses, and identifying/mapping conflict zones and response initiatives.
- Writing/proofreading articles and reports, and analyzing conflict-related data (i.e. population needs, replacement patterns, and damages).
- Mental health and crisis counseling.

Online volunteers support to emergency response:



Relief aid distribution

Assessing needs, systematizing, verifying data, and preparing progress reports on relief delivered.



Shelter provision

Systematizing and verifying that shelter specifications are aligned with guidance and standards for shelter.



Public and mental health

Providing health-related counseling, case management, trauma care, and psychological support.



Communications and visibility

Photo and video production & editing, subtitling, public information, monitoring media for misinformation.



Linguistic and editorial

Translation, interpretation, drafting and proof-reading, producing training and learning materials & courses.

Examples of Online Volunteer Actions

Ukraine: Online Volunteers in times of war

- 370+ Online Volunteers have been requested to support 14 UN entities in 13 countries.
- Areas of collaboration: IT-related tasks, data and reporting, counselling, translation and interpretation, programme support, event management, research and mapping, talent acquisition, public information and support in digitalization.

Peru: Online Volunteers for zero hunger

- 600+ Online Volunteers teamed up with WFP to support migrants arriving in Peru.
- Online volunteers undertook 20,000+ phone calls to 7,100+ migrant families, provided them information and guidance on nutrition and social protection issues.

From Türkiye and Syria to Sudan: Online Volunteers are a resource for UN crisis response

- 20+ online volunteers were an additional resource to aid UN humanitarian efforts in Türkiye, Syria, and Sudan during emergencies.
- Promoting well-being, mental health, and psychosocial support for OCHA staff and their family members, through counseling sessions and the translation of materials.
