UN Volunteers are a unique resource for UN partners to support a holistic COVID-19 vaccination campaign. They can help with tasks such as procuring the vaccines, communicating vaccine safety, identifying target groups, managing medical supply and cold chain, administering vaccinations, and monitoring the vaccine's impact. They can also support delivery, digital solutions and the inclusion of vulnerable groups.

**Duty of care**: UNV ensure that all volunteers are covered with health insurance and will facilitate a smooth deployment.

UNV has a diverse, highly skilled Talent Pool in Asia Pacific. With over 52 thousand candidates ready for deployment in a range of volunteer modalities, UNV can cater directly to partner needs. Half of UNV's candidates in the region have over 5 years' experience and 40% are women.
