UNV partners with OHCHR to promote and protect human rights that are guaranteed under international law and stipulated in the 1948 Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Volunteer action widens spaces for engagement, enhances protection and builds trust and resilience.

Volunteerism is intrinsically rooted in SDG 17, and mobilizes people to leverage collective action and engagement across all the SDGs.

UN Volunteers work within communities, making them well-placed to monitor and document human rights situations, support research analyses and build capacity and improve inclusive participation and engagement of communities.

OHCHR invested a financial volume of US \$1,038,000 in UN Volunteers in 2016. During 2016, 62 UN Volunteers served with OHCHR.

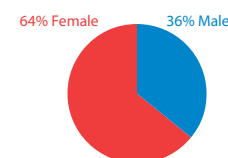

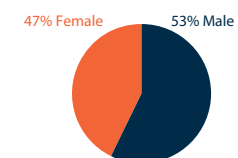

UNV attaches great importance to gender equality and national capacities, and provides high ratios of female as well as national UN Volunteers, adding to the diversity of OHCHR's workforce.

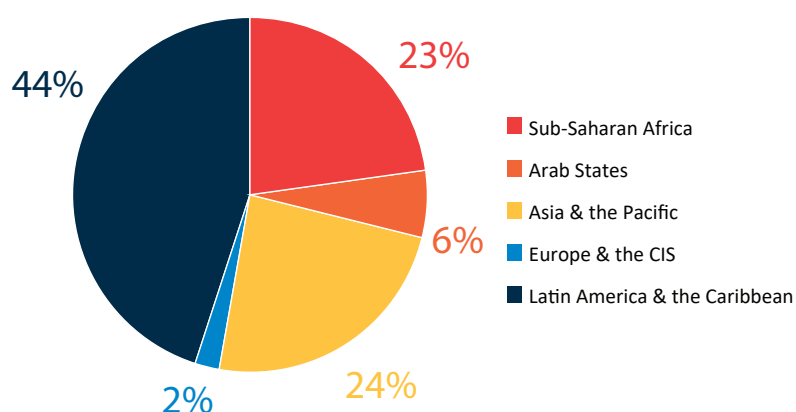
UN Volunteers contribute to OHCHR strategic priorities



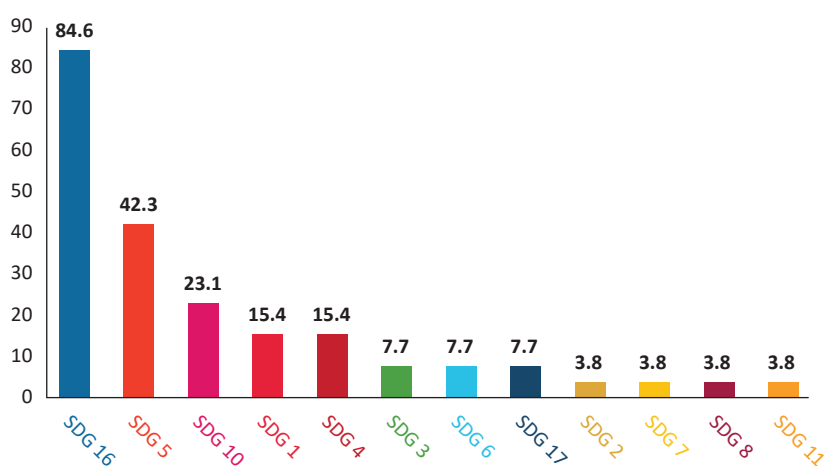
Note: UN Volunteers selected which of OHCHR's strategic priorities their assignments contributed to most. This graph indicates percentages of 25 respondents.

UN Volunteer assignments with OHCHR by region (2016)



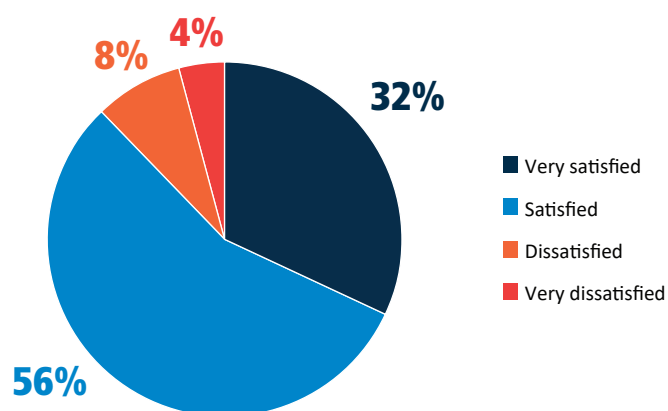
UN Volunteer assignments with OHCHR contribute to the SDGs
