UNV PARTNERING WITH OHCHR DATA SNAPSHOT

UNV partners with OHCHR to promote and protect human rights that are guaranteed under international law and stipulated in the 1948 Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Volunteer action widens spaces for engagement, enhances protection and builds trust and resilience. Volunteerism is intrinsically rooted in SDG 17, and mobilizes people to leverage collective action and engagement across all the SDGs.


UN Volunteers work within communities, making them well-placed to monitor and document human rights situations, support research analyses and build capacity and improve inclusive participation and engagement of communities.

OHCHR invested a financial volume of US \$979,000 in UN Volunteers in 2015. In 2015, UN Volunteers completed 52 assignments with OHCHR. From January to October 2016, 59 UN Volunteers have served with UNHCR.

UN Volunteers contribute to OHCHR strategic priorities








UN Volunteer assignments with OHCHR by region (2015)




UN Volunteer assignments with OHCHR contribute to the SDGs
