

Security Policy Summary - UN Volunteers

Security Inclusion

UN Volunteers and their recognized primary dependents (i.e. spouses, recognized partners, or recognized union, or children who are single and under 21) who are authorized to reside at the duty station are covered by the United Nations Security Management System (hereinafter the “UNSMS”)

Security Policy Guidance

The unified Conditions of Service Section XI and Annex 04 contain important provisions on UNSMS, security and security evacuation/relocation measures.

Relocation within country of assignment	DSA of authorized location applies	50% of applicable DSA of authorized location per each UNSMS eligible family member
