Impact

UNV proximity to affected countries through its Multi-Country Field Unit in Tunis covering Maghreb. Agile team. Availability of direct recruitments (direct contract of candidates locally identified by WHO, Deployment within two weeks for competitive processes (depending on profile required, availability, visa). Possibility to identify relevant candidates directly from the UNV Global Pool.



Flexibility

Solutions can be implemented in both Libya and Tunisia. Large variety of UN Volunteer categories under both the National and International types. Flexible contract durations from 3-48 months (depending on the volunteer modality). Possibility of secondment. Possibility of working remotely according to WHO rules and regulations.

Cost-effective

The Proforma cost estimate for a 12-month national UN Specialist is USD 32,258 in Libya and USD 15,394 in Tunisia. For the UN Community Volunteer solution, the 12-month proforma is USD 12,310.

Flexible and speedy volunteer capacity from around the world to support WHO rapid crisis and emergency response. From mapping needs and damage assessment to collecting data and preparing situation analysis. Online Volunteers can be engaged for up to 20 hours per week and for up to 12 weeks.
